**Language Arts**

This month in Language Arts students will be reading three short stories: "The Three-Century Woman," "The Wreck of the Titanic," and "Talk with an Astronaut." Students will be learning more about multisyllabic words, and unusual spellings. Students will be learning about literary elements starting with the character and plot. Lastly students will be learning about word structure. Many English words are based on Greek and Latin roots, students will use this to figure out what a word means.

Mathematics

This month, students will explore relationships of measurements, constructing figures and classifying geometric shapes and figures. In this chapter, students will also investigate the properties and parts of circles, concepts of symmetry and tessellations. In addition, students will learn about measurement of angles, finding the perimeter of a polygon and the circumference of a circle.

Science

This month, students will understand the Earth's position in the solar system and why Earth supports life. Students will explain what orbits the Sun and explore the Milky way galaxy. In this lesson, we will compare and contrast the different planetary system in our galaxy and what characteristics they share. Furthermore, we will learn about the different types of stars that are in our universe

History

This month in History students will be starting chapter 7 "The Fight for a Continent." Students will be learning about New Mexico, and how the Pueblo leader Pope led a revolt against the Spanish. Students will learn about New Orleans and how the French established a port city near the mouth of the Mississippi River. Lastly students will learn about Fort Necessity where George Washington's troops lost a battle to French soldiers.

Islamic Studies

Inshallah, we will begin the month with our finals which will cover unit A and B. After this we will resume with unit C and learn about Muslims under siege during the life of our beloved Prophet (S). We will cover the battle of Ahzab. We will also go through the Tafseer of Surat Al Mursalat.
