## Curriculum Overview: Grade 1

### Language Arts : Scott Foresman - 2008

- Build a reading vocabulary of high frequency words
- Independently read grade appropriate material
- Improve skills to become an effective reader
- Have command of letter names and sounds that is initial, medial, and final
- Focus on speaker and listen with appropriate attention span
- Identify text that uses sequence or other logical order
- Follow one step written instructions
- Read with fluency in a manner that sounds like natural speech
- Begin to use convention in spelling, punctuation, and grammar
- Print legibly with spaces between words
- Listen and recall some facts and main ideas
- Apply spelling patterns
- Respond to who, what, where, when and how questions
- Share and participate in class discussions
- Express ideas in complete sentences and stay with the topic
- Use age appropriate vocabulary and speech understood by others

### Mathematics : Sadlier Oxford -2008

- Count by ones past 100, by twos, fives, and tens to 100
- Read, write, understand, and use numbers up to 100
- Represent equivalent forms of the same number
- Count and group objects in ones and tens
- Compare the lengths of two or more objects
- Recognize and make reasonable estimates when comparing larger and smaller quantities
- Demonstrate fluency with basic number combinations for addition and subtraction facts
- Create and solve story problems
- Classify objects by their attributes
- Collect, organize, and represent data
- Interpret and draw conclusions from data
- Identify and know the value of coins and show different combinations of coins that equal the same value
- Tell time to the nearest half hour and relate to events
- Add and subtract two digit numbers and solve addition problems with three addends
- Identify one, two and three equal parts of a whole
